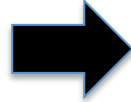


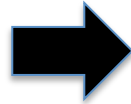
Question Card for Fiction (Not true stories)

Before Reading



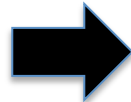
- What does the title/cover tell us?
- Can you predict what is going to happen? What makes you think that?

During Reading



- Listen to the reading.
- Praise.
- If they pause or make an error, wait for five seconds before prompting them.
- What do you think will happen next?
- What is the problem in the book?
- Why do you think the character did that?
- When you were reading this part, what were you picturing in your head?

After Reading



- What do you know about the main character(s) so far?
- What do you think he/she is like? How do you know that?
- What do you think will happen next? Why do you think that?
- Does the story have a theme? What do you think it is?
- What are the important words on this part of the text?
- Let's retell the story together.



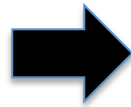
Question Card for Non Fiction (True stories)

Before Reading



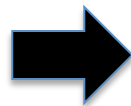
- What does the title/cover tell us?
- What do you know about this topic already?
- How does table of contents, index and glossary help you?

During Reading



- Listen to the reading.
- Praise.
- If they pause or make an error, wait for five seconds before prompting them.
- What clues can you see in the pictures, diagrams, maps or charts?
- What clues can you get from the labels, legends or captions?

After Reading



- What is this page/paragraph /sentence about?
- What are the important words in this part of the text?
- What is the main idea of the text?
- What is the author trying to tell us?
- What have you learned from this text?
- Are there questions that you asked yourself that the author didn't answer? Where could you find the answers to those questions?
