Late Entries: We would rather not turn children away, but **we really have to draw the line at large numbers of late entries** (1 or 2 competitors we can usually fit in).

Please be aware that each team is limited to 9 competitors, and as soon as the registration cut-off date has passed, **it cannot be guaranteed that a competitor will be placed in the desired team** – e.g. Ambulant competitor may have to be put in the Walking Frame team (where there is a space).
