On average, across reading, writing and mathematics, the number of students who were working within the curriculum range for their age increased from 50% to 85%. This year has seen our building renovations finally completed! Our Year 7 block now has wonderful learning spaces and a fire escape large enough to hold a party! Our students have been amazing during the build accommodating the building fencing, restricted grounds and unique classroom spaces.

The team placed 8th in what was a Secondary Division! This is an unbelievable result on the back of our other New Zealand National Titles this year. The whole team has demonstrated great commitment and talent throughout the year.

Congratulations to both of our Futsal teams who placed first and second in the Intermediate Division recently and to Ridha Parker who is the New Zealand winner of the 'What's your Story' competition, winning \$1000 (Australian) and having her work published on their website. Well done Ridha!

Our Culture groups, including Bollywood Fusion group, Pasifika groups performed recently at the Eden Albert Cultural festival, held at Rocket Park. They did a fabulous job representing our School and celebrating culture! Special thanks to Ms Pushpa Bishwa, Mrs Toreka Brain and Ms Ioane for their work all year with these groups.

## School Stream App

We have replaced the previous App with the School Stream App. Instructions on how to get the School Stream app on your mobile device are as follows:

- iPhone /iPad iOS
1. From your mobile device go to the App Store and search for School Stream
  2. Tap the FREE/GET button to the right of the School Stream listing
  3. Tap the INSTALL button
  4. Enter your Apple ID and password & tap OK
  5. Wait for the install icon to change to OPEN, Tap the OPEN button
  6. You will be prompted to accept push notifications, you will need to select OK
  7. Start typing Mt Roskill Intermediate into the search then SELECT Mt Roskill Intermediate
- Android / Tablet
1. From your mobile device go to the Play Store and search for School Stream
  2. Tap the School Stream Listing
  3. Tap the INSTALL button
  4. Tap the ACCEPT button
  5. Wait for the app to install then tap the OPEN button
  6. Start typing Mt Roskill Intermediate into the search then SELECT Mt Roskill Intermediate
  7. Tap the DONE button in the top left.

## School Bus from Papatoetoe / Mangere Bridge
