



Mt Roskill Intermediate AIMS Selection Procedure

Anchor AIMS Games is an inter-school sporting competition for young sportspeople across New Zealand and the wider South Pacific.

Every September, many thousands of 11 to 13-year-olds gather in Tauranga to compete against their age in a variety of individual and team sports. For many, this is their first experience of a super-scale sports event, complete with an opening ceremony, professional livestream coverage and world-class facilities. Anchor AIMS Games encourages an active life, fair play, and participation across a variety of sports. Many professional Kiwi athletes have come through the Games on their way to specialisation and achievement on the world stage.

The following is how MRI facilitates the school's involvement in NZ AIMS.

- Parents or guardians can express interest in a particular sport or team attending AIMS.
- Contact will be made with SLT and Sport Coordinators to facilitate a trial in this sport. The trial will be run and overseen, by school staff with outside input at the schools discretion.
- Overall selection in these teams will be made by school staff, and the final decision will lay with the school.
- Upon Confirmation of the chosen team, related parents and guardians will be invited to organise and facilitate this teams attendance at the NZ AIMS games.
- Overall responsibility for organising the team will lay with the parents, however ultimate authority over the team lies with the school.
- School will contribute where appropriate, however, parents and guardians need to be aware of the significant undertaking that organising an AIMS team is.
